

Testing Protocol for Eastman Site-Specific Courses

The minimum passing grade for a student taking the Eastman Site-Specific Training is 80%.

If a student's first attempt at taking the test results in a failing score, the student must take and pass the SCTC English Language Comprehension Exam (ELCE). The minimum passing grade for the ELCE is 70%.

If the student fails the ELCE they will be suspended for a period of 90 days.

If the student passes the ELCE with a grade of 70% or above, he will be allowed to retake the Eastman Site-Specific. The student must make the minimum score or above in order to pass the Eastman Site-Specific. If the student fails on his second attempt, he will not be allowed to retake the Eastman Site-Specific and will be suspended for 90 days.
